Safety First

Power cord protection

To avoid any malfunctions of the receiver, and to protect against electric shock, fire or personal injury, please observe the following.

Hold the plug firmly when connecting or disconnecting the AC power cord.

Keep the AC power cord away from heating appliances.

Never put any heavy object on the AC power cord.

Do not attempt to repair or reconstruct the AC power cord in any way.

Never make or change connections with the power switched on.

Placement

Avoid placing the receiver in areas of:

Direct sunlight, heating radiators, closed automobiles, high temperature (over 35°C), high humidity (over 90%) or severe dust as the internal parts may be seriously damaged.

Non-use periods

When the receiver is not being used, turn it off. When left unused for a long period of time, the receiver should be unplugged from the household AC outlet.

No fingers or other objects inside

Touching internal parts of the receiver is dangerous, and may cause serious damage to the unit.

Do not attempt to disassemble the receiver.

Do not put any foreign object in the receiver.

Keep away from water/magnet

Keep the receiver away from flower vases, tubs, sinks, etc. If liquids are spilled into the receiver, serious damage could occur.

Never bring a magnet or magnetized object near to the receiver.

Stacking

Place the receiver in a horizontal position and do not place anything heavy on it.

Condensation

Moisture may form on the remote control lens in the following conditions:

Immediately after a heater has been turned on in a steamy or very humid room.

When the receiver is suddenly moved from a cold environment to a warm one.

If moisture forms inside the receiver, it may not operate properly. In this case, turn on the power and wait about one hour for the moisture to evaporate.

Introduction

The Uniden SD5000UPVR Set-Top-Box is an MPEG-2 compliant Digital receiver, capable of receiving and recording Standard Definition (SD) TV programmes from free-to-air terrestrial broadcasts (DVB-T).

The user friendly On-Screen-Display (OSD) allows you to set-up your receiver to enjoy SD digital channels with clear picture and stereo sound quality.

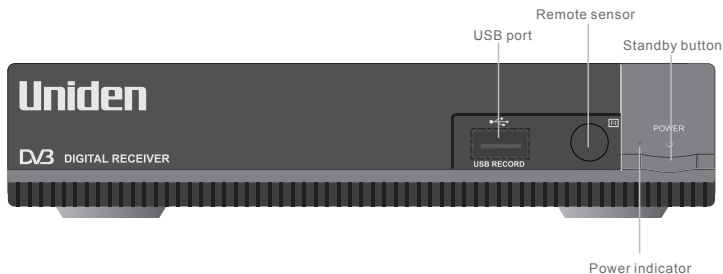

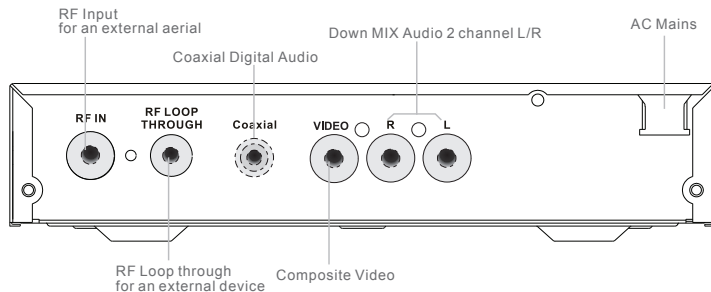

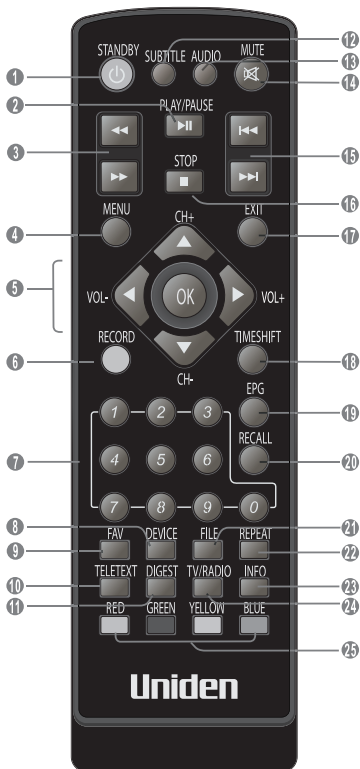

Play/Pause the video or audio in playback mode

3. ◀◀ / ▶▶:

Rewind / Forward during playback mode

4. MENU: Open/Close the Menu screen

5. CH+/CH-/VOL+/VOL-/OK:

Menu ▲▼◀▶ navigation buttons.

Channel Up/Down and Volume Up/Down.
OK - Confirm a selection within a menu.

6. RECORD:

Start Programme Record funtion

7. Numeric (0-9):

For entering channel number or PIN code

8. DEVICE:

View the USB Storage Drive's Read/Record/Timeshift compatibility

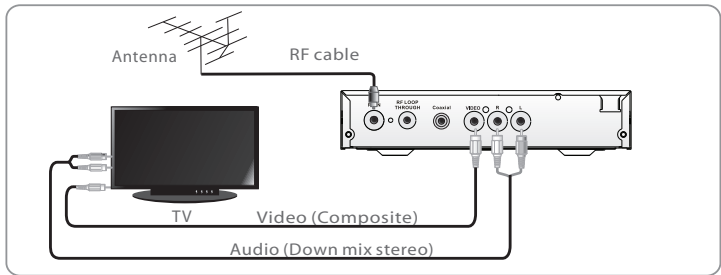

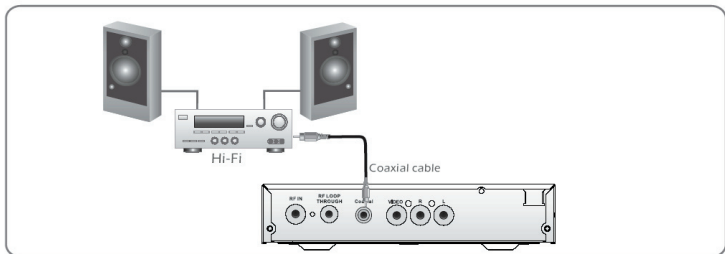

Aspect Ratio Setting

Digital TV broadcasts carry a mixture of TV programmes filmed in widescreen (16:9) and standard (4:3) formats.

The SD5000UPVR's Aspect Ratio setting is preset to **AUTO** to automatically detect the aspect ratio of the TV programme. You may change the aspect ratio (see Menu/DigitalTV/Settings/TV page 26) to one of the following options:

AUTO

16:9 - Widescreen

4:3 LB - Letter Box

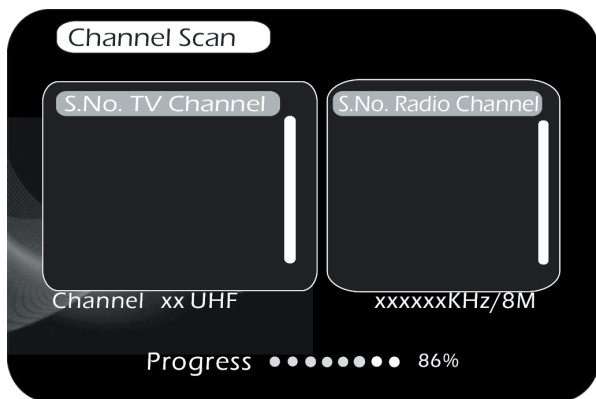
4:3 PS - Pan Scan

Recognising that viewers may not always be satisfied with the broadcaster's recommended display format or choice of formats, TV sets may also have a 'viewer preference' setting, in which the viewer's wishes override that of the broadcaster, the viewer will have to select these other modes deliberately.

Switching on for the first time

Your SD5000UPVR needs to be tuned to channels in your region. When it is connected and switched on for the first time the SD5000UPVR will automatically start in Auto Scan mode.

1. Turn on your TV set and select the input (with the AV key, or similar, on the television remote control).
2. Turn on the SD5000UPVR by pressing the power key on the front panel or pressing **STANDBY** on the remote control. The power indicator on the front panel will light up green.
3. The SD5000UPVR will automatically begin Auto Scan to tune into local frequencies. The tuning status screen displays.



4. When tuning is finished Standard Definition (SD) Digital channels are then received.

HD channels may also be tuned, however the SD5000UPVR will not display these channels. You can delete HD channels from the channel list using the Channel Organiser menu - see page 21.

Viewing Channels

Changing the Channel

Use the Channel keys ▲▼ or enter the channel number on the remote control to change channels.



Only SD channels can be viewed. HD channels which may have been tuned during scan cannot be viewed. Use the Channel Organiser menu on page 21 to delete HD channels from the channel list.

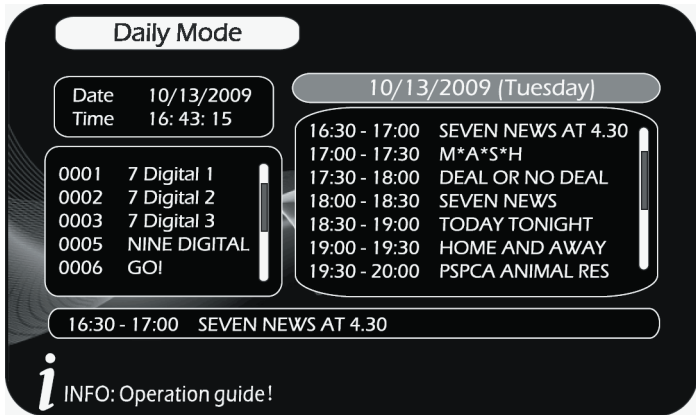
Change Channel by Channel list

1. Press **OK** in channel mode to enter the “QUICK SELECT” window.
2. Press **UP** or **DOWN** to select desired channel then press **OK**.



Change Channel by Electronic Programme Guide (EPG)

1. Press **EPG** to open the “Electronic Programme Guide” window.
2. Select the desired channel and then press **OK**.

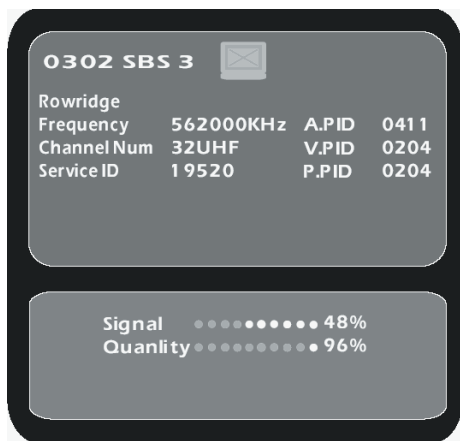


The Information Window

1. When viewing channels (Viewing Mode) press **INFO** to view the TV programme information where you can see the now and next programme information.



2. Press **INFO** while the Now/Next window is showing to view the Broadcaster details.



NOTE

In Menu mode pressing **INFO** opens the key guide

Recording TV Programmes

The SD5000UPVR can record television programmes onto a USB mass storage drive.

The storage drive read/write speed must meet the requirement speeds below for optimum performance.

Playback mode (read speed > 1Mbps)

Record mode (write speed > 8Mbps)

Time shift mode (write speed > 30Mbps)

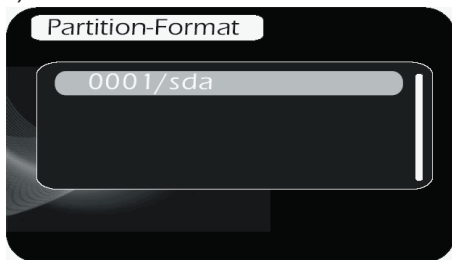
To check if a USB storage drive is compatible connect it to the USB port and then press **DEVICE**. The storage drive read/recorder/timeshift compatibility will be indicated by the colour spot next to the device listing.



It is recommended you format the Storage Drive before use. The SD5000UPVR only supports FAT/FAT32 formatting of the USB Storage Drive.

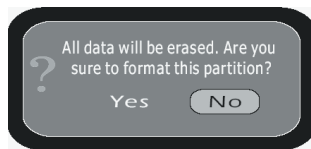
Format the USB Storage Drive

1. Press **MENU** then select “Format USB Storage”.
2. Press the **OK** and then enter the PIN code (the default PIN code is 0000).



3. A window of the connected USB device path (e.g. 001/dev/sda/1) will appear. Press **OK**.

4. Select “YES” then press **OK** to format the Storage Drive.



A partition (separate folder) will be created on the Storage Drive for recorded TV programmes.



NOTE

For long recording times a USB hard drive (instead of a USB flash drive) is recommended.

Caution:

- All the files saved in your USB Storage Drive will be erased when formatting.
- Do not disconnect the USB Storage Drive while formatting. It may cause damage to your USB Storage Drive.

Start /Stop Recording

In viewing mode:

1. Press **RECORD** to begin recording function.
2. Press **STOP** to stop recording function.

Timeshift Function

The Timeshift function records a TV programme to a buffer (drive space on an external USB Storage Drive). Timeshift offers the ability for you to then pause, forward or rewind the TV programme before the it has completed broadcasting. At the end of Timeshift you can choose to save the recorded buffer for later viewing.

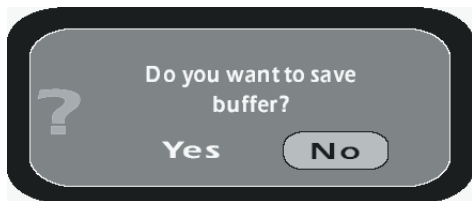
Start/Stop Timeshift

In viewing mode press **TIMESHIFT** to begin timeshift record.



During Timeshift, it is possible to perform the following actions:

1. Press **PLAY/PAUSE** to play/pause the playback
2. Press **▶▶** to fast forward the playback
3. Press **◀◀** to rewind the playback
4. Press **EXIT** to stop Timeshift. A confirmation window will appear asking if you wish to save the recorded buffer.
5. Select "Yes" to save the Timeshift buffer to the recorded programme or select "No" to delete the recorded buffer.

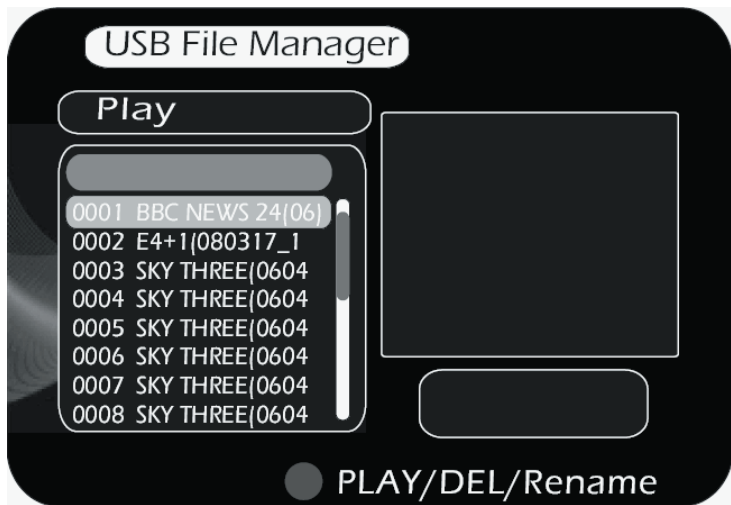


Playback Recorded TV Content

USB File Manager

TV Programmes you have recorded using normal Record or saved from the Timeshift buffer are stored on the USB Storage Drive.

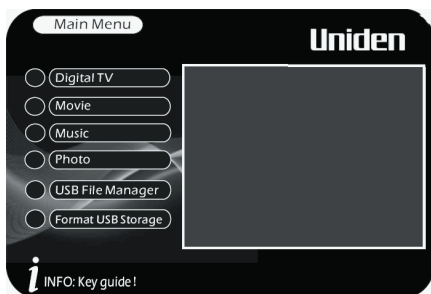
1. Press **MENU** to enter the Main Menu.
2. Select “USB File Manager”. The USB File Manager window will display.
3. The files are available for “PLAY”. Press the Green colour button to change the select action between “PLAY”, “DEL” or “Rename”.
4. Select the desired files and then press **OK** to action.



Main Menu

Press **MENU** to enter the Main Menu. Use **▲▼◀▶** to navigate to a selection and the press **OK** to select.

Press **INFO** to view a key guide for the displayed window.



Channel Manager

Channel Organiser

Allows you to set a channel to the Favourites list or channel locked (Parental Lock) list.

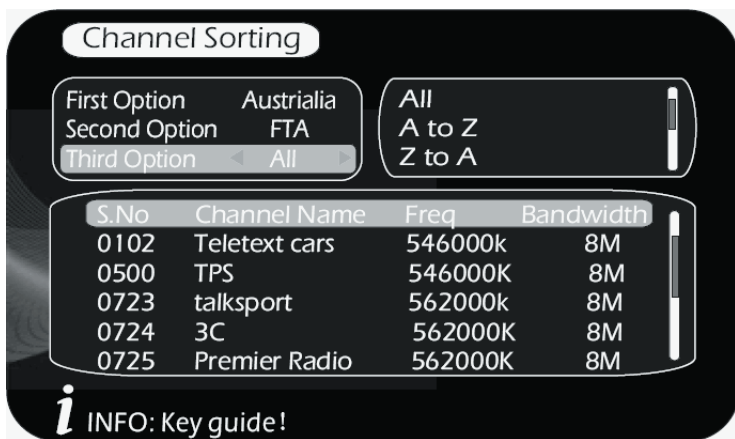
1. Press **MENU** to enter Main Menu.
2. Press **OK** three times to enter “Channel Organizer”.
3. Select a channel and use the colour keys to organise the channel.



Channel Sorting

Use this window to sort the channel lists.

1. Press **MENU** to enter Main Menu.
2. Press **OK** twice to enter Channel Manager.
3. Select “Channel Sorting” and then press **OK** to enter the “Channel Sorting” window.
4. Use **▲▼◀▶** to select the sort filter and then press **OK**.
5. Enter the PIN code (default PIN code is 0000) to confirm.



Channel Grouping

Use this window to tag channels into groups (e.g. News, Science, Sport, Movie, Kids, Music, Fashion).

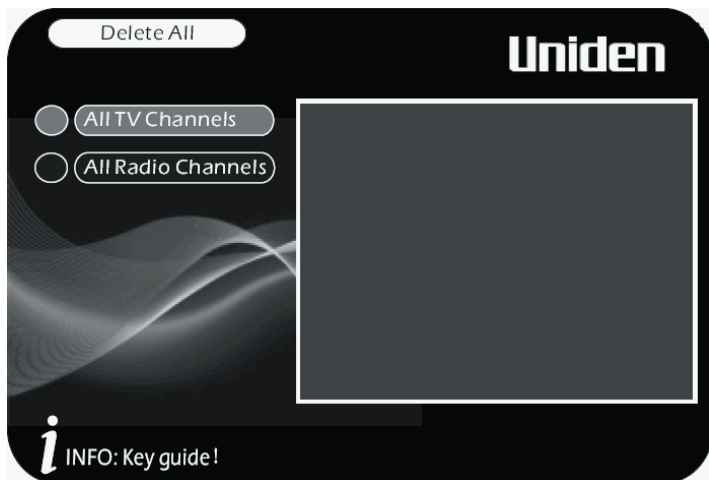
1. Press **MENU** to enter Main Menu.
2. Press **OK** twice to enter Channel Manager.
3. Select “Channel Grouping” and press **OK** to select the “Channel Grouping”.
4. Select a channel and then press the numeric button to tag the channel into a group.



To use Channel Grouping press **OK** when in viewing mode to display the “Quick Select” list and then use ◀ or ▶ to change the group lists.

Delete All (Channels)

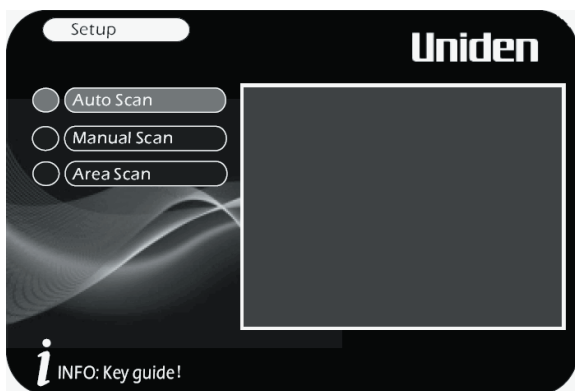
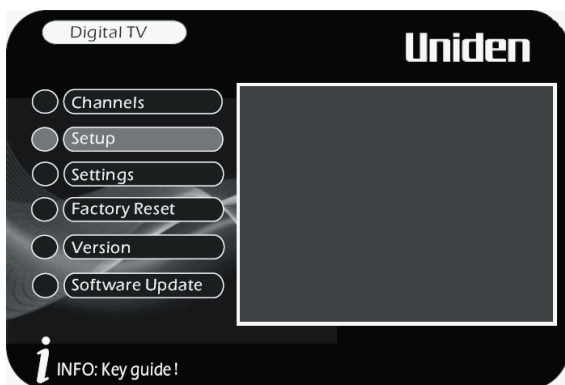
1. Press **MENU** to enter the Main Menu.
2. Press **OK** twice to select “Channel Manager”.
3. Select “All TV Channels” or “All Radio Channels” and then press **OK**.
4. Enter the PIN code (default 0000) to confirm.



Setup

Use the Setup menu to scan for local channels.

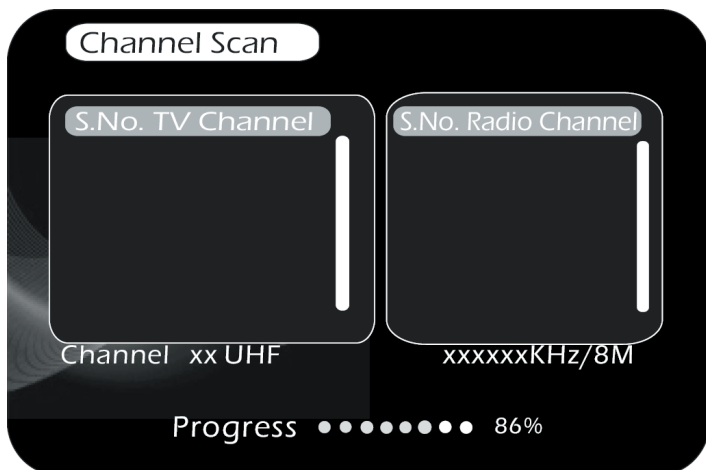
1. Press **MENU** to enter “Main Menu”.
2. Press **OK** to highlight “Digital TV”.
3. Select “Setup” and then press **OK** to confirm.



Auto Scan

Use Auto Scan to automatically scan for local channels.

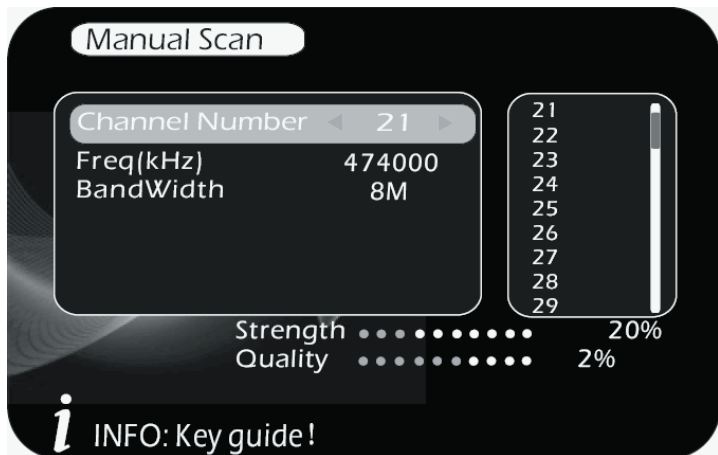
1. Press **MENU** to enter the Main Menu.
2. Press **OK** and select “Setup”.
3. Press **OK** and select “Auto Scan”
4. Auto Scan will begin immediately.



Manual Scan

Use Manual Scan to scan for individual channels.

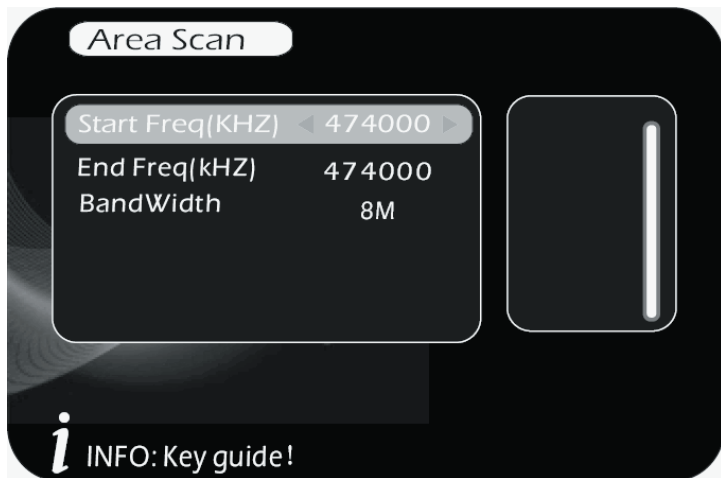
1. Select “Manual Scan” and then press **OK**.
2. Press ◀ or ▶ to select the Channel Number to scan for.
3. Press **OK** to begin scan.
4. Press **OK** to begin scan.



Area Scan

Use Area Scan if you know the frequency or frequency range of local channels.

1. Press **MENU** to enter the Main Menu.
2. Press **OK** and select “Setup”.
3. Press **OK** and select “Area Scan”
4. Use the numeric buttons to enter the “Start Freq(kHz)”
5. Enter the “End Freq(kHz)” if available.
6. Select the “BandWidth”.
7. Area Scan will begin immediately.



Settings

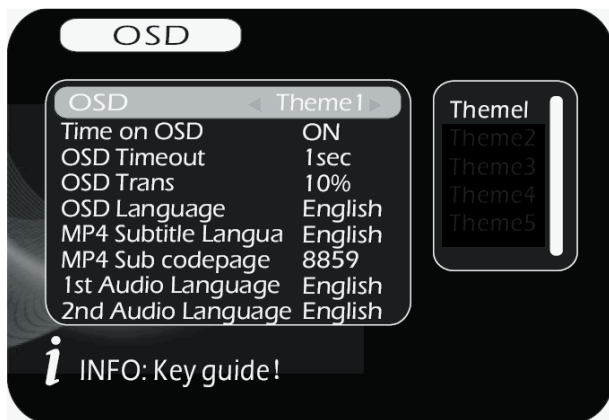
Many aspects of your SD5000UPVR can be set to reflect your circumstances and preference. The Settings menu screen is accessed from Main Menu. The Settings contains On Screen Display (OSD), TV, System Setup, Time, Wakeup Timer, Parental Lock. Setting changes will be effective after you EXIT the Main Menu.

On Screen Display (OSD) Set up

This menu allows to set the OSD information based on the viewer preference.

1. Enter the "On Screen Display" OSD menu from the Settings menu.
2. Select the desired option.
2. Press ◀ or ▶ to select the desired setting for each option.
3. Press **OK** to set.

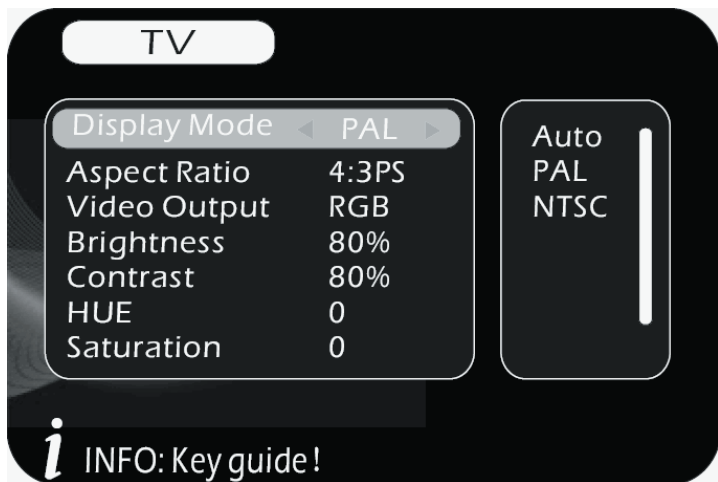
NOTE: When the "Time on OSD" is on, the subtitle function is automatic off.



TV Set up

Use the TV Set up menu to change the TV picture settings.

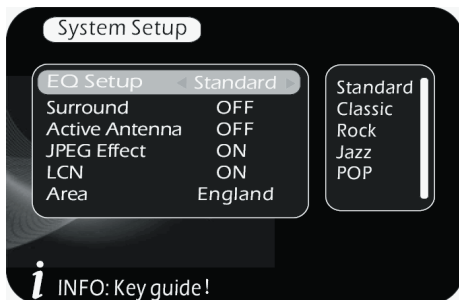
1. Enter the “TV” menu from the Settings menu.
2. Select the desired option.
3. Press ◀ or ▶ to select the desired setting for each option.
4. Press **OK** to set.



System Setup

Use the System Setup menu to change system settings.

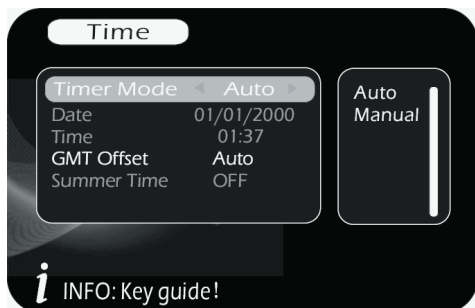
1. Enter the “System Setup” menu from the Settings menu.
2. Select the desired option.
3. Press ◀ or ▶ to select the desired setting for each option.
4. Press **OK** to set.



Time

Use the Time menu to change date & time settings.

1. Enter the “Time” menu from the Settings menu.
2. Select the desired option.
3. Press ◀ or ▶ to select the desired setting for each option.
4. Press **OK** to set.



Wakeup Timer

Use the Wakeup Timer menu to set the SD5000UPVR to record TV programmes on a timer basis. You can schedule up to 7 wakeup timers. There are 3 ways to enter the Wakeup Timer menu.

Entering through the main menu:

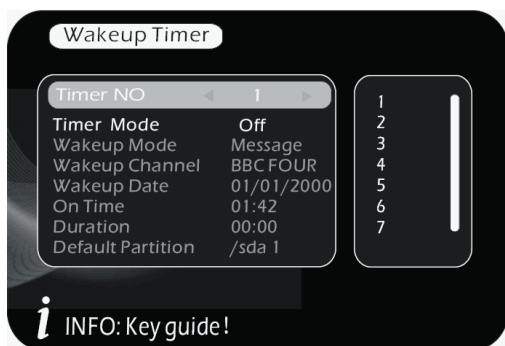
1. Enter the “Wakeup Timer” menu from the Settings menu.
2. Press ◀ or ▶ to select the desired setting for each option.
3. Press **OK** to set.

Entering through the EPG:

1. Press **EPG** to enter the EPG window.
2. Press ◀ or ▶ to enter an event.
3. Press ▲ or ▼ to select the event.
4. Press Blue colour button to enter the “Wakeup Timer” menu.

Entering through the BLUE button:

Press the Blue colour button to enter the Wakeup Timer menu directly.



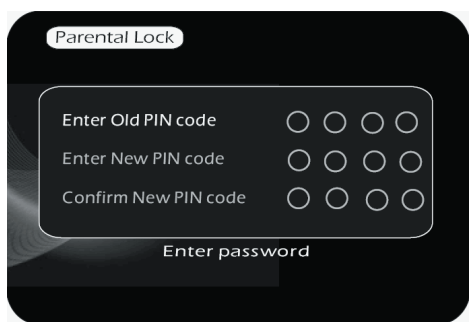
NOTE

EXIT all menus and the system will save your setup.

Parental Lock

Use this window to set the PIN code for secure access menus and parental lock channels (see Channel Organiser - page 21).

1. Enter the “Parental Lock” menu from the Settings menu.
2. Use the numeric buttons to enter the Old PIN code, New PIN code and confirm the New PIN code.
3. Press **OK** to set.



The default password is 0000.

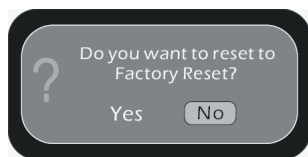
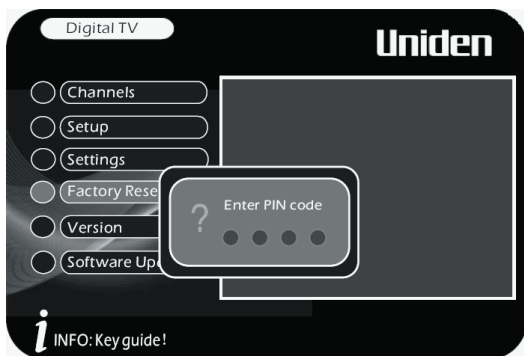

Factory Reset

You can re-set the SD5000UPVR back to factory settings and clear all existed channels.

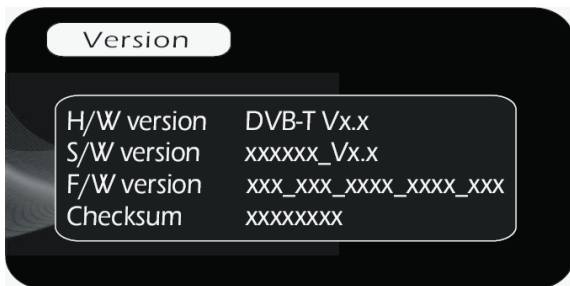
1. Enter “Factory Reset” from the “Digital TV” menu.
2. Enter the PIN code to proceed (default PIN code is 0000).
3. A confirmation window is displayed. Select “Yes” and then press **OK** to return back to factory settings and clear all channels. Select “No” and press **OK** to cancel the reset.
4. Press **EXIT** to exit.



Version

The Version menu displays the version details for the SD5000UPVR.

1. Enter the “Version” menu from the “Digital TV” menu.



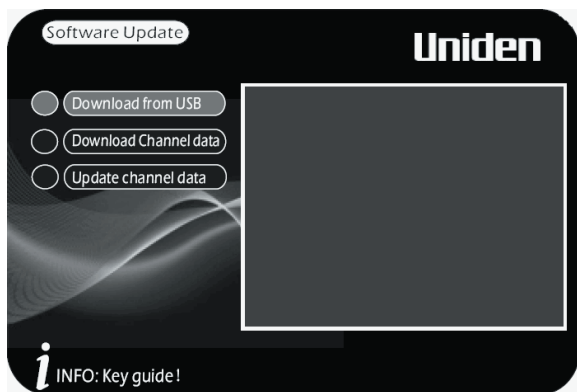
Software Upgrade

The software for the SD5000UPVR may be upgraded in future. Visit the website www.uniden.com.au for the latest information.

- Copy the software file to the root folder of a USB Storage Drive and connect to the SD5000UPVR.

1. Press **MENU** to enter the “Main Menu”.
2. Press **OK** to select “Digital TV”.
3. Select “Software Upgrade”.
4. Press **OK** to select “Download from USB” and then select the upgrade file.
5. Press **OK** to upgrade.
6. Enter the PIN code if required.

You can save and retrieve your (organised, sorted...) channel data using the “Download Channel Data” and “Update Channel Data” options in the update menu.

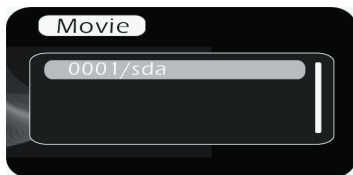


Playing Multimedia Content

You can play multimedia content that is stored on the USB Storage Drive. This function allows you to play video (XVID, MPEG I/II, DivX 4/5), audio (MP3, WMA) or photo (JPEG) file formats).

Movie Playing

1. Press **MENU** to enter Main Menu.
2. Select "Movie".
3. Move the cursor to enter the route of the desired video files.
4. Press **OK** to play the desired video files.



Music Playing

1. Press **MENU** to enter Main Menu.
2. Select "Music".
3. Move the cursor to enter the route of the desired video files.
4. Press **OK** to play the desired video files.

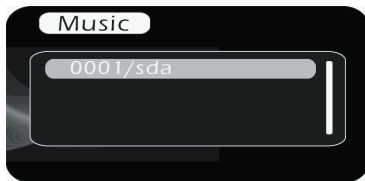
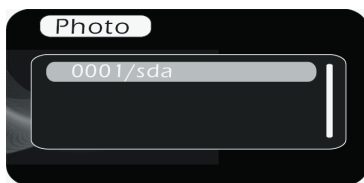


Photo Playing

1. Press **MENU** to enter the Main Menu.
2. Select Photo.
3. Move the cursor to enter the route of the desired photo files.
4. Press **OK** to view the photo.
5. Press **OK** to start slideshow.



Press the RED colour button once, and then press **OK** repeatedly to zoom the photo at 2,3,4,1/2,1/3,1/4 levels.

Troubleshooting

In some region, the digital terrestrial signal may be weak. So you'd better use the antenna in which the booster was built, for watching the weak signal channels.
